

Chamber Accomplishments

The Tucson Metro Chamber continues to work on promoting a strong local economy. The Chamber moved ahead, setting positive directions for our community, taking important stands on legislation, collaborating with other business groups, and working to help all businesses, large and small alike.

Local Government Victories

Worked with Tucson's City Manager and Council to build a more business-friendly atmosphere, including:

- **Parking Code Rewrite** ... worked with a stakeholder group to rewrite the City of Tucson's Parking Code, adopted by Mayor and Council;
- The Economic Stimulus Stakeholder Group for the City of Tucson ... Resulted in the deferral of impact fees, saving builders the debt carrying costs;
- City of Tucson Land Use Code ... Continuing participation in reorganize effort the code;
- Facilitation of the Development Services Stakeholders Group ... Resulted in significant redesign of the development standards;
- Transportation ... Advocated for High-Speed Rail to be included in the State Transportation Plan;
- **Military Community Relations Committee and Davis-Monthan** ... Chamber strongly supported the relationships between Davis-Monthan, the 162nd Air Nation Guard and the Tucson community;
- Pima Association of Government Environmental Planning Advisory Committee ... Advocated for reasonable and manageable environmental policies.
- City/County Water/Waste Water Study ... Chamber advocated for inclusive process and long term business friendly growth policies.

Federal and State Victories

- At the Arizona Legislature your Chamber successfully lobbied in support of bills that gave us; an
 Unemployment Special Assessment that protects the amount Arizona businesses pay; laws that will
 protect your business from medical marijuana; Reduced corporate taxes, structural changes to
 Development Impact Fee, various Workman's Compensation bills, Medical Malpractice reform that
 raised the Burden of Proof for lawsuits, reformed the State Pension Fund and ensured Rio Nuevo funding
 remained.
- In Congress, your Chamber opposed Card Check to keep secret ballot Union Elections, opposed the federal Healthcare legislation, while advocating for sensible Health insurance reform and fought for more Federal Transportation dollars for Arizona.
- The **Chamber** continues our efforts to reduce or eliminate regressive taxes and burdensome regulation

- **Skilled Employee Resource Committee ...** Developed and chaired by Chamber staff, was designed to help highly skilled job seekers find suitable employment;
- JTED Advisory Board ... Represented the "Business-Management Administrative Services";
- Tucson Center for Cultural Enrichment ... Funded seven \$2,000 scholarships for deserving high school students in the community;
- **State of Education Luncheon and Expo...** Hosted this event to showcase successful Career and Technical Education programs, such as bioscience and engineering, in local high schools.
